Why is this document important?

Our website, www.essepiwood.it (hereinafter: "the website") uses cookies and other related technologies (for convenience all technologies are referred to as "cookies"). In the document below we inform you about the use of cookies on our website and how we process your personal data.

What are your rights?

In cases provided for by law, you have the right to access your data, to request its rectification and cancellation; you also have the right to limit or object to the processing of your personal data; furthermore, you have the right to the portability of your data. Furthermore, you have the right to revoke at any time the consent granted to the Data Controller, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal.

Important

You (9) can exercise your rights and revoke your consent by giving us notice at the indicated addresses. In addition, you can lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority or contact the judicial authority if you believe that the processing of your data is against to the law.

What are cookies (and other means of tracking)?

In a similar way to many other websites, we use cookies and similar technologies

Cookies are small text files that are stored within your internet browser by the websites that you visit to understand more about your visit and help us to enhance your experience.

Functions usually performed by a cookie can be achieved by other means, such as by using pixel tags.

We refer to cookies and these other technologies generically as Tracking Tools.

For all the specific information on the Tracking Tools of this site, their data storage and how to manage them please read our Cookie Policy.

These are technical and complex issues: if you have any doubts or requests contact us, we will be happy to help to you!

Technical Tracking and Tracking Tools

They are essential: they are used for the proper functioning of the site.

They are used to navigate or provide a service requested by the user. They are not used for other purposes and are normally installed directly by the website owner.

Without the use of such cookies, some operations could not be accomplished or would be more complex and/or less secure, such as home banking activities (display of the account statement, transfers, payment of bills, etc.), for which cookies, that allow you to make and maintain user identification within the session, are indispensable.

Important

The user's consent is not required for their installation.

Statistics Cookies

We use statistics cookies to study, and then improve, how users interact with our website.

Analytics cookies allow us to gather specific information about our site, we cannot use them to find out details such as your name or address. In any case they can't be used for commercial purposes.

Third parties who provide the site owner with these measurement services must not combine the data, even minimized, with other processing (for example customer files or statistics of visits to other sites) or transmit them themselves to other third parties (unless the production of statistics with data minimized interests multiple domains, websites or apps traceable to the same owner or business group). In any case, the analysis of the measurements carried out must never result in an activity that, going beyond the boundaries of a mere statistical count, actually takes on the characteristics of a processing aimed at making decisions of a commercial nature.

Important

Are assimilated to the Technical Tracking Tools apply the same rules in terms of information and consent) only: when processed directly by the site owner if used to optimize the site by collecting statistical information in aggregate form on the number of users

and how they visit the site or how much processed by third parties if user data are previously minimized and cannot be combined with other processing or transmitted to additional third parties in all other cases the user's consent is required.

Preferences cookies

These cookies enable this website to save information on your shopping preferences including filtering your searches to display the most relevant products to you.

Important

This Tracking Tools are not used unless you give your consent. It is possible to modify or withdraw at any time the consent for each type of Tracking Tools using the dedicated tool, present on every page of the site.

Marketing and third-party cookies

Aside from setting cookies ourselves, we also allow carefully-selected third parties to set cookies and pixels during your visit to our website. The Third-Party Tracking Tools cannot be completely controlled by the Data Controller, therefore for further information, we encourage you to read the third-party providers' policies. In any case, if you have any doubts or requests contact us, we will be happy to listen to you!

(Third party cookies collect information about your browsing habits in order to make advertising more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advert as well as help measure the effectiveness of an advertising campaign)

Social media cookies

Many social media cookies are set through plugins, widgets, and sharing buttons

Social media cookies are **cookies used to connect a website to a third-party social media platform** to share






The Data Controller's website may also use plugins and sharing buttons, which determine the presence on the site of third-party tracking tools (C.d. cookies for social networks).

Cookies for social networks are used to verify the interest and/or share the contents of the Data Controller's website on social media (for example on Facebook). The information collected by these cookies may be transmitted to the third parties providing the service (for example Facebook).

The plugins and/or sharing buttons (C.d. social button/widget) are presented as icons of social networks (for example Facebook) and other websites. By clicking on it, users who are browsing the website of the Data Controller can interact directly with social networks and other websites: in this case, the social network and other websites acquire data related to the user's visit.

(Necessary cookies cannot be switched off, however, in [Cookie Preferences](#), you can withdraw consent for statistics, preferences and marketing cookies. You can also manage your cookie preferences by changing your browser settings so that cookies are not accepted. Duration of storage and place of processing

Why do we use cookies?

The collected data are used by the website owner for the proper functioning of the site in order to provide the service requested by the user

Important

They are necessary for the proper functioning of the site / app / portal, so for their installation you do not need the user's consent

Preferences

The data owner is allowed to collect information about your browsing habits in order to send advertisement more relevant to the users and their interests.

Why do we use cookie?

Functionality of the site

They help website to remember information about your visit, which can both make it easier to visit the site again and make the site more useful to you.

Consent is required for this purpose: you can reject or withdraw consent for cookies any time but please be aware that the website may no longer function as intended.

Tracking: Cookies are used for various aspects of functionality such as keeping track your browsing habits in order to improve the site service.

Legal foundation: consent

Important

For this purpose, consent is required. You can revoke your consent to the processing of your data at any time by giving us notice (opt-out). If you reject or withdraw consent, the website may no longer function as intended.

Tracking

The Data Controller processes personal and browsing data to generate statistics on the use of the website / app / portal in order to track and monitor user behaviour. The treatment is also aimed at improving the service.

Tracking

Cookies are used for various aspects of functionality such as keeping track your browsing habits in order to improve the site service.

Examples of statistics generated by the Tracking process

- 🔗 page views
- 🔗 visitors per day
- 🔗 number of visitors per time slot
- 🔗 geographical area of origin of visitors

Legal foundation: consent

Important activity carried out through analytics cookies and in some cases the law provides that the user's consent is not necessary

Type of data processed with cookies

Navigation data

The computer systems and software procedures that operate this site, during their normal operation, acquire certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols

These data are necessary to use the services of the site and are used anonymously and/ or aggregated to receive statistical information on the use of the site and to check its proper functioning. Once processed, they are automatically deleted (subject to any need for detection of crimes by the judicial authority)

Examples of browsing data IP addresses or domain names of computers and terminals used by users' addresses in URI/URL notation of the time-requested resources, method used to send the request to the server and the size of the file obtained in response to the numeric code indicating the status of the response given by the server (good end, error, etc) parameters related to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

How to manage cookies

Cookie banner

A cookie consent banner is the cookie notice that is shown on websites and some apps on the user's first visit: You can give or reject consent (except for necessary cookies for the proper functioning of the site, which will always be active) to choose for which categories of cookies give consent and to change the choices made previously at any time by giving us notice (opt-out).

In addition, you can manage the Tracking Tools also through the settings of individual devices, which allow you to set your preferences.

Browser

You can reject or withdraw consent for cookies any time but please be aware that the website may no longer function as intended.

Essential glossary

-  Personal data: any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual;
-  Dissemination: giving knowledge of the data to indeterminate subjects, in any form, including through their availability or consultation. For example: publication of a photo online or on a social network
-  DPO. Data protection officer, liaising with Data Controller and Data Subject
-  Data subject: The identified or identifiable living individual to whom personal data relates.
-  Data controller: it is a person, company, or other body that determines the purpose and means of personal data processing
-  Processing: any operation or set of operations, performed with or without the aid of automated processes and applied to personal data or sets of personal data
